VTOS Eligibility Requirements	VTOS, aged 21 and over and be in receipt of unemployment payment for 156 days (6 months).
VTOS Programme Supports	 Receive VTOS training allowance at a rate equivalent to the Jobseeker's Benefit instead of your jobseeker's payment. VTOS participants under 26 who move from an age-related reduced rate of Jobseeker's Allowance will get a rate of €160 per week. VTOS training allowance and work: If you are returning to your course for a second year, you will continue to get your VTOS allowance during the summer months. You can also take up full-time work during the summer months and your VTOS payment is not affected. BTEI Eligibility Requirements	BTEI, aged 18 and over, who left full-time education can take part.

Childcare Supports	Yes, on-site Pre-School at the Centre (free of charge) or places on Childcare Education Training Supports (CETS), both subject to availability.
