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Back to Education Initiative (BTEI)

What is the Back to Education Initiative?

The Back to Education Initiative (BTEI) provides part-time further education programmes for young people and adults. The aim is to give people an opportunity to combine a return to learning with family, work and other responsibilities.

Who can take part in a BTEI programme?

Anyone who has left full-time education can take part. However, priority will be given to those with less than upper level second level education.

What will a BTEI course cost?

Tuition is free to any adult, however, priority will be given to those with less than upper second level education and to those in receipt of a social welfare entitlement or medical card. The remainder will be charged fees.

Will I obtain certification for a BTEI course?

Certification is offered to all participants.
